A docu-reality themed 'Being a girl' or similar topics is to be created by girl students from Navy Children Schools, under the guidance of professionals from the film industry. The selected participants would undergo a seven-day workshop at Mumbai, wherein they would interact with industry, experts, and indulge in movie making and editing with the assistance of professionals.

Selection Criteria:

- Girl students of classes VIII-XI from Navy Children School Delhi will be selected to participate in the project.
- Selection of student would be done in two stages.
- Stage1: 15 girl students will be shortlisted.
- Stage 2: An eminent panel of judges comprising experts will shortlist the participants after stage one for the final workshop.

School level screening

Interested students to:

(a) Write a 300-word essay on any of the following topics:

1. Importance of freedom of speech for women.
2. Combating gender discrimination within family.
3. Life in Navy family.
4. Any woman-oriented subject/issue.
5. Any children-oriented subject/issue.

(b) Write 300 - 350 words short story on their personal experiences of being a woman in modern India. The participants are not to limit their creativity and write a personal story that is close to their hearts.
